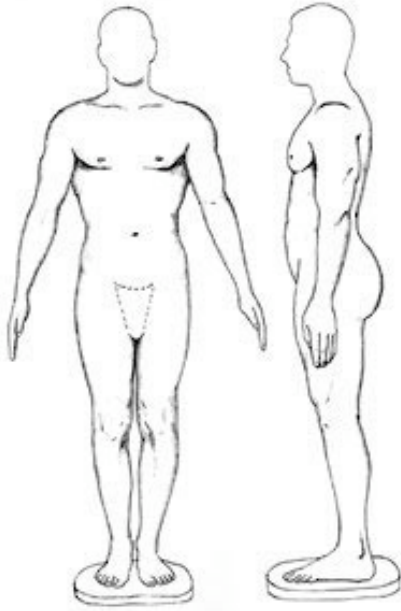

How You Compare?

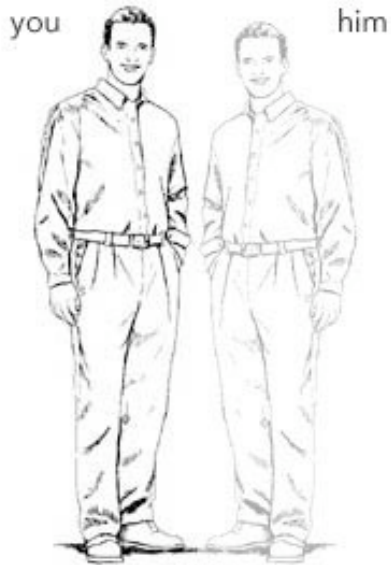
